<p>We appreciate that many people wish to place a floral tribute at their memorial rose bush. We must ask however, that this be restricted to one modest tribute of freshly-cut flowers per rose bush. We provide a plastic spiked vase for this purpose. This floral tribute and the plaque we supply are the only items that may be placed on or by the rose bush. Any other items will be removed by Crematorium staff.</p> <p>If the rose bush needs, for whatever reason, to be replaced, we will do so with as near a match as possible to the original rose. We normally carry out replacements between the months of November and March.</p> <p>I confirm that I have read and agree to the conditions above and wish to lease the rose bush for a period of ten years.
